Brief List of Marks

I used ↔ to symbolize that there are two opposite things.

I used an exclamation mark (!) to symbolize a command.

I used < to say that a certain word is derived from another similar word.

Notes

When a somewhat obscure verb form appeared in the Greek text, I often clarified by showing another form of the same word in its corresponding infinitive form. Concerning verbs, I changed them to their corresponding infinitive forms. With nouns and adjectives, I changed them to their nominative, singular forms. I chose the less common, more difficult words to put in the footnotes. If there was a graphic that I chose to illustrate an abstract or difficult word, but I thought the graphic could be interpreted by the user in multiple ways, I placed the definition below in the footnotes for complete clarity, so that the reader would not have to guess the definition. Finally, I put any word that could be explained in image form in the picture dictionary, even if the words are common in the Greek New Testament and did not appear in footnotes.

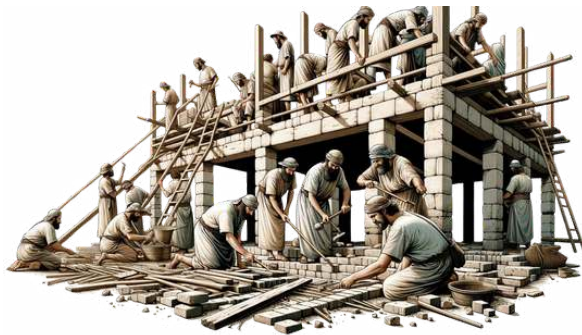

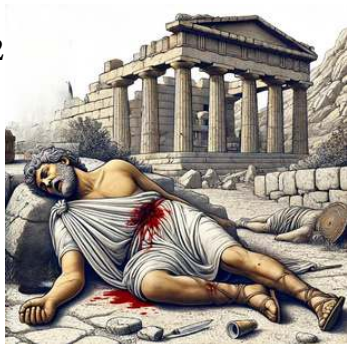

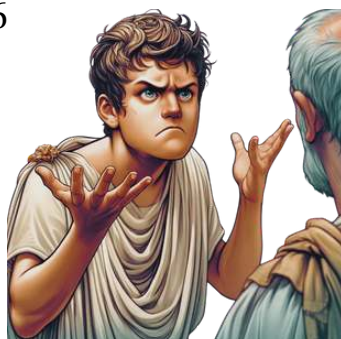
